## ROOT INSTRUCTIONS



Branch



Hook



Two Prong Branch



Join Branches to create a long tap Root

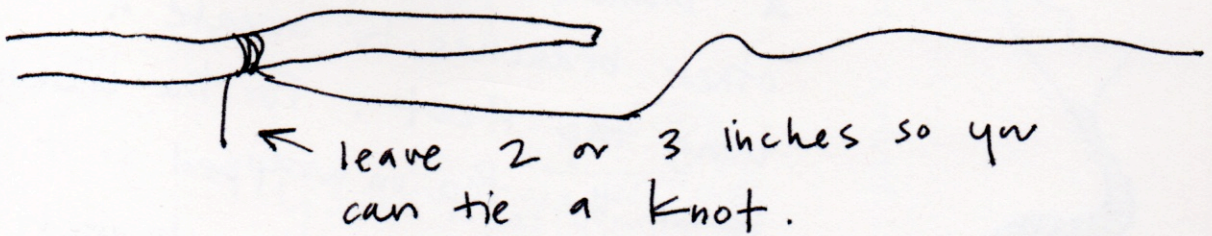


You want to make a cross wrap as you bind the paper



Avoid a circular wrap as it tends to unravel and slide

STEP 1. when you start binding a branch begin in the middle and wrap the white thread 2 or 3 times tightly around the paper. crunch and squeeze the paper as you wrap to create a tight root.




STEP 2. wrap the thread on a diagonal crunch and bend the paper as you wrap to give the root character so it is not a straight line.



Step 3. When you reach the end fold over the tip to create a hub.

wrap back up the root in the opposite direction to create an X (cross wrap).

Step 4. Make a Knot when you reach the 2 or 3 inches of thread where you initially wrapped the paper.

Step 5. You can make a loop 

OR



a branch to be attached to other branches to create a long tap Root. For the branches leave the top un wrapped so it can be attached to another branch.

OR



connect branches to create a long tap root.
